# Give An Hour Scheme



### FOR SOLICITORS, LAW FIRMS AND FINANCIAL ADVISERS Hourglass is the only UK-wide charity dedicated to ending the abuse of older people.

- It's estimated 2.7 million people across the UK are affected by the abuse of older people, yet it's rarely reported in the media or discussed in Parliament.
- In 2022-23 we doubled our impacts with over 26,000 people reaching out to Hourglass' helpline and information services, seeking advice, support and information related to the abuse of an older person.
- Our helpline team are contacted by victims, those affected by abuse and those worried about the safety or wellbeing of an older relative or friend.
- Hourglass does more than just help those calling the helpline. We provide Independent Domestic Violence Advocates, Domestic Abuse Officers and case work support, as well as awareness raising events in local communities.
- Hourglass helps those affected by physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, financial abuse, psychological abuse and domestic abuse.
- Older victims face unique barriers to accessing the support they need. Many older victims have a lifetime of abuse but don't recognise abusive behaviours, they might rely on a perpetrator for care, they may struggle with digital literacy or fear that they won't be believed.
- Hourglass is a lifeline in the most complex of cases and we want to ensure our callers have a full understanding of the best options available to them.

Hourglass 'Give An Hour' is seeking the support and expertise of solicitors, law firms and financial advisers to offer potentially life changing information to some of our callers. You could be part of making a real difference to the lives of older people at risk of abuse.

# Your expertise could make a huge difference to vulnerable older people at risk of abuse.

We were contacted by a family member who was concerned about an elderly relative she felt was being financially abused. Our helpline team advised her to talk with a legal professional experienced in this area who was able to help.

This is what she said:

"I contacted you in desperation as my lovely aunt, who had been diagnosed with Alzheimer's, was being financially abused. At the time of contacting you, I had been constantly hitting brick walls, as I had no legal rights as my aunt's niece. You were my last hope.

I am so grateful to you because the recommended solicitor managed to salvage this complex situation which I thought would be impossible to do. Had you not been there, I would have very likely just given up. You do a fantastic job and thank you again"

Another family contacted us with concerns that their grandmother was being financially abused.

"I just wanted to say thank you from our family, without the help of John I am not sure that I would have gone back to the bank or the police, and my grandma would not have had her entire life savings back.

It goes without saying that your organisation and the help and support that John gave us will be remembered by our family for a long time to come, and I am sure that my grandma would appreciate your input in helping her to have her own money in her final years".
